Keswick View – Privacy Policy

This policy sets out how Keswick View ("we") process any personal data that we collect from you or that you provide to us through our website. We confirm that we will keep your information secure and that we will comply fully with all applicable UK Data Protection legislation and regulations.

Types of information we may collect from you

- **cookies.** Our website may use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

How we may use the information we collect

We use the information in the following ways:

Information you supply to us. We may use this information:

- to provide you with information and/or services that you request from us;
- to provide marketing information based upon your stated preferences

Information we may automatically collect about you. We may use this information:

- to administer our site including troubleshooting and statistical purposes;
- to improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- security and debugging as part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure.

This information is collected anonymously and is not linked to information that identifies you as an individual.

Disclosure of your information

We use a trusted third party "SuperControl" to manage our online booking process. We have a written contract with SuperControl to ensure that they will process your data on our behalf in compliance with all applicable Data Protection Laws.

SuperControl process any data collected through this website in a secure manner as instructed by us. SuperControl cannot access, provide, rectify or delete any data that they store on our behalf without our permission.

We do not rent, sell or share personal information about you with any other people or companies.

We will use all reasonable efforts to ensure that your personal data is not disclosed to regional/national institutions and authorities, unless required by law or other regulations.

Transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.
